

# An Additional Way To Pay Your Rent – Chase QuickPay™

## Setting Up Chase QuickPay for a NON- Chase Customer:

- Setting this up takes a number steps plus a couple of days to verify the account but the steps are easy to follow and it only has to be done once.
- You will need the routing number and account number for the bank account you are going to use to make the payment. For those that have a PayPal account Chase will ask you to verify your account in a similar manor.

Then, log on to Chase Online, click "External Accounts" on the Transfer Money tab and find your account. Click "Verify" next to your account and enter the two deposit amounts to verify that you own the account.
